SOAL Marine Group and **Offshore Special Services** close an agreement to jointly develop the new **TRAINING CAMP MEDITERRANEAN**.

The companies Offshore Special Services (OSS) and SOAL Marine Group have joined forces for the launch of a new project that will be carried out in the Region of Murcia (Spain), at its Base in Mazarrón. This alliance is part of the ambitious training project in the sector of public service professionals, which OSS is forming on the Murcia coasts and that has already attracted other multinationals in areas such as specialized diving, or work at height.

With this new alliance, the Mazarrón Training Center will include in its catalog the **Spectre Marine Training** courses, focused on the training of high-speed boats at sea and related applications, such as realistic exercises with helicopters and repair and maintenance of engines for the military, police, and rescue sectors.

Among the areas of specialized training that Spectre Marine develops are stealth navigation, high-speed navigation, interdiction and boarding, familiarization of assault boats, repairs to small engines, launch and recovery from ships, air operations with small boats, operation of drones from boats and search and rescue.

The school will also be established as a training center for **Kraka Jet Board** products that will allow users of these devices, designed to support special operations and rescue, to be trained both in their manual and remote driving versions.

This highly specialized training aims to complete the training offer of the school of Mazarrón in the maritime domain, becoming a world center of reference for professionals in these sectors. Thanks to its privileged location, with direct access to the Bay of Mazarrón of 49 km of extension, and its Mediterranean climate, characteristic of the Region of Murcia, the training center allows to simulate scenarios that complement the Camps that SOAL maintain in for example Sweden and Indonesia.
